2	<input type="checkbox"/>	One passport size colour photograph, white background, maximum 6 months old; For picture specifications please visit https://www.it.ckg.s.ae/photo-specification
3	<input type="checkbox"/>	A valid passport (and a color copy) satisfying the following criteria: - its validity shall extend at least three months after the intended date of departure from the territory of the Member States or, in the case of several visits, after the last intended date of departure from the territory of the Member States; - it shall contain at least two blank pages; - it shall have been issued within the previous 10 years; - it shall hold a valid UAE visa.
4	<input type="checkbox"/>	Photocopy of UAE Residence Visa valid at least 90 days from the return date
5	<input type="checkbox"/>	Previous Schengen, USA, or UK visa photocopy.
6	<input type="checkbox"/>	No Objection Certificate from local sponsor/employer with copy of Passport and UAE visa of the signatory. <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Name and designation of the applicant- Name and designation of the managerial signatory- Signatory direct phone and e-mail- Applicant's monthly salary- Start of employment date
7	<input type="checkbox"/>	Company License;
8	<input type="checkbox"/>	Employment Labour Contract;
9	<input type="checkbox"/>	Verifiable evidence of sufficient means of subsistence during intended stay: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- a) last 3 months payslips;- a) last 3 months bank statements (foreign bank accounts will not be considered);- b) a valid international credit card accompanied by the relevant last 3 months card statements;- c) any other document that might help evaluate your financial situation in the UAE (i.e. Other bank accounts, personal properties, investments, etc...). Bank Statement should be on a bank letterhead. Photocopies or online statements must bear the original bank stamp.
10	<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of the Official Seafarers Identity Document;
11	<input type="checkbox"/>	Employment contract from the naval company, duly signed by both parties.
12	<input type="checkbox"/>	Confirmation letter by Italian Harbour Authorities ("Capitaneria di Porto") of the actual presence of the ship.
13	<input type="checkbox"/>	Invitation letter from the shipping agent (if available), with name of the signatory and a copy of his ID/Passport.
14	<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of the Italian Agency "Visura Camerale" issued in the last 6 months.
15	<input type="checkbox"/>	Medical travel insurance: minimum coverage euro 30,000 inclusive of emergency repatriation flight and repatriation of mortal remains. Insurance policy must be issued by an UAE based insurance company;
16	<input type="checkbox"/>	If the seafarer is expected to enter the Schengen area before the boarding date, a confirmed hotel booking is required.
17	<input type="checkbox"/>	Confirmed flight booking;
