Damaged passports will not be accepted.

5	<input type="checkbox"/>	Previous Schengen, USA, or UK visa copy.
6	<input type="checkbox"/>	No Objection Certificate from local sponsor/employer mentioning: <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Name and designation of the applicant;○ Start of employment date;○ Applicant's monthly salary;○ No objection to travel to Italy;○ Duration and purpose of leave;○ Name and designation of the managerial signatory;○ Direct phone number and e-mail of the signatory;○ Provide copy of passport and UAE visa of the signatory.
7	<input type="checkbox"/>	Employment Labor Contract / agreement.
8	<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of a valid trade license.
9	<input type="checkbox"/>	Verifiable evidence of sufficient means of subsistence during intended stay: <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Last 3 months pay slips;○ Last 3 months bank statements (foreign bank accounts will not be considered);○ A valid international credit card accompanied by the relevant last 3 months card statements;○ Any other document that might help evaluate your financial situation in the UAE (i.e. other bank accounts, personal properties, investments, etc...). Bank Statement should be on a bank letterhead. Photocopies or online statements must bear the original bank stamp.
		Letter from Hospital/Clinic accredited by Regional Health Authorities, stating the medical condition of the patient.
		Letter released by the Hospital/Clinic in Italy stating the admission of the patient and mentioning the exact length of the treatment (start and finish date).
		Declaration of the Hospital/Clinic stating the total cost of the treatment and the payment of at least 30%.
10	<input type="checkbox"/>	An international medical insurance covering the entire stay with a minimum of 30.000 € coverage and full and unlimited coverage for hospitalization. Emergency repatriation flight as well as repatriation of mortal remains must be included. Detailed table of benefit must be provided.

If one of the parents is abroad, he/she will be asked by the Consulate to contact the nearest Italian Consulate/Embassy in order to sign the consent letter in front of an officer; ○ Birth certificate: No birth certificate is required if the full name of both parents/legal guardians are mentioned (in English) in the applicant's passport; If not, an original or certified copy of the birth certificate (translated in Italian or English), duly legalized by the Italian Embassy/Consulate in the Country where the document has been issued, must be provided; ○ Divorced parents: Original/legalized copy of the divorce sentence with clear mention of full custody (translated in Italian or English); <p>Originals and/or certified copies will be returned if a copy is provided.</p>
