1	<input type="checkbox"/>	National Application form duly completed and signed.
2	<input type="checkbox"/>	One passport size color photo, white background, maximum 6 months old (see specifications);
3	<input type="checkbox"/>	A valid passport (and a copy) satisfying the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ its validity must be at least three months longer than the visa requested;○ it must contain at least two blank pages;○ it must have been issued within the previous 10 years;○ it must hold a valid UAE visa. Damaged passports will not be accepted.
4	<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of a valid UAE Residence Visa with a residual validity of no less than 150 days.
5	<input type="checkbox"/>	Previous Schengen, USA, or UK visa copy.
6	<input type="checkbox"/>	The visa applicant intending to start a business activity in Italy, must submit a clear and detailed business plan, demonstrating that he will invest in the project own resources, coming from legitimate sources, not lower than 500.000 euros. The business plan should involve the creation of at least 3 new job positions, and clearly mention in detail the process that will lead to the goal.
7	<input type="checkbox"/>	NOC issued by the competent Italian administrative authority, in the event that the possession of authorizations or licenses, declaration concerning initiation of business or registration in a specific register, are required. The date of the declaration must not be older than three months.
8	<input type="checkbox"/>	Authorization ("Nulla osta") from the relevant Police headquarters ("Questura") released in the last 3 months.
9	<input type="checkbox"/>	Benchmarks certification regarding the financial resources necessary for the implementation of the investment project. The certification is mandatory even for activities that do not require qualifications or authorizations issued by the Chamber of Commerce, Industry, Crafts and Agriculture (Chamber of Commerce, Industry, Crafts and Agriculture) competent for the place in which the activity will be carried out autonomously or by the competent professional associations. The certification must in any case be for an amount not less than triple the sum equal to the capitalization, on an annual basis, of the monthly amount of the social allowance. Income can be considered lawfully produced even if it is not generated in the Country of residence, but from foreign sources; in this case it must in any case be certified by suitable documentation produced in the country of residence. The date of the declaration must not be older than three months;
10	<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of an income, originating from legal sources, higher than the minimum amount provided by the Italian law for the exemption from the payment of medical assistance services. The aforementioned minimal income requirement needs to be proved through documents certifying the income earned during the previous financial year by the applicant in his/her Country of residence, such as a labor contract in the UAE, last 12 month pay slips and bank statements duly stamped by the bank (foreign documents must always be legalized by the Italian Embassy/Consulate in the Country where they originates).
11	<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of a valid trade license in the UAE.
12	<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of the certified consolidated financial statements ("bilanci consolidati") of the applicant company (if any) of the last 2 years.

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13	<input type="checkbox"/>	An international medical insurance with a minimum of 30.000 € coverage and full and unlimited coverage for hospitalization. Emergency repatriation flight as well as repatriation of mortal remains must be included. Detailed table of benefit must be provided.
14	<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of suitable accommodation in Italy. The following documents are accepted: - agreement for the purchase or rental of a property; - statement made by an Italian or foreign national legally residing in Italy, in accordance of art. 46 and 47 of DPR 349/1999, confirming that they have made available to the visa applicant a suitable accommodation that comply with the minimum standards laid down in the relevant regional law regarding public housing accommodation;
15	<input type="checkbox"/>	A flight booking. During the Pandemic we strongly advise the applicant to book a direct flight in order to avoid any problems due to the possible implementation of additional access restrictions in the transiting Countries.

I understand that an application without a complete set of documents may result in the refusal of my visa application. The submission of a complete file does not guarantee the issuance of a visa. The passport will not be returned until the final decision on the visa is adopted. The Consulate General reserves the right to ask for a Personal Interview or any additional documents.
