Damaged passports will not be accepted.

5	<input type="checkbox"/>	Previous Schengen, USA, or UK visa copy.
6	<input type="checkbox"/>	Copy of the authorization (Nulla Osta) of the Italian Immigration Office (Sportello Unico per l'Immigrazione) released in the last 6 months (4 months requests falling under the Dlgs 286/1998, art. 27).
7	<input type="checkbox"/>	Local Employment Labor Contract / Agreement.
9	<input type="checkbox"/>	No Objection Certificate from local sponsor/employer mentioning: <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Name and designation of the applicant;○ Start of employment date;○ Applicant's monthly salary;○ No objection to travel to Italy;○ Duration of leave;○ Name and designation of the managerial signatory;○ Direct phone number and e-mail of the signatory; Provide copy of passport and UAE visa of the signatory.
9	<input type="checkbox"/>	Italian Employment Labor Contract / Preliminary Agreement, mentioning: <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Name and designation of the applicant;○ Start of employment date;○ Applicant's monthly salary;○ Name and designation of the managerial signatory;○ Direct phone number and e-mail of the signatory; Provide copy of passport or ID of the signatory.
10	<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of suitable accommodation in Italy. The following documents are accepted: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- registered rental agreement;- Hotel booking of no less than 30 days;- statement made by an Italian or foreign national legally residing in Italy, in accordance of art, 46 and 47 of DPR 349/1999, confirming that they have made available to the visa applicant a suitable accommodation that comply with the minimum standards laid down in the relevant regional law regarding public housing accommodation;
11	<input type="checkbox"/>	An international medical insurance with a minimum of 30.000 € coverage and full and unlimited coverage for hospitalization. Emergency repatriation flight as well as repatriation of mortal remains must be included. Detailed table of benefit must be provided.



12	<input type="checkbox"/>	Confirmed flight booking. During the Pandemic we strongly advise the applicant to book a direct flight in order to avoid any problems due to the possible implementation of additional access restrictions in the transiting Countries.
