The application must be submitted at least 15 days before the intended travel date. Failing to do so will result in the application to be returned.

2	<input type="checkbox"/>	One passport size color photo, white background, maximum 6 months old (see specifications);
3	<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>A valid passport (and a copy) satisfying the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ its validity must be at least three months longer then the visa requested;○ it must contain at least two blank pages;○ it must have been issued within the previous 10 years;○ it must hold a valid UAE visa. <p>Damaged passports will not be accepted.</p>

5	<input type="checkbox"/>	Previous Schengen, USA, or UK visa copy.
6	<input type="checkbox"/>	A color copy of a valid passport of the EU citizen family member;

Marriage/Family status/Birth certificate (original and one copy).Marriage/civil partnership certificates older than 6 months will NOT be accepted;2. Certificates issued by an UAE authority must be:<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Legalized by UAE MOFA and by the relevant Italian Consular Office in the UAE.b. Translated in Italian by an officially recognized translator, translation itself must be legalized by the relevant Italian Consular Office;3. Certificates issued by one of the Schengen countries will be accepted only if multilingual, otherwise please refer to the following notes;4. Certificates issued by a foreign authority other than the UAE, must be:<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. If issued in a Country signatory of the Hague 1961 Convention, certificates may be Apostilled.b. Otherwise, Certificate must be legalized by the relevant Italian Consular Office in the issuing Countryc. In any case, Translated in Italian by an officially recognized translator, translation itself must be legalized by relevant Italian Consular Office;5. Italian nationals' spouses - whose marriage certificate has been already registered in Italy or in the Italian consular network as required by <u>DPR n. 396/2000</u> - are exempt from providing an updated version of the above-mentioned certificate. Instead, they are required to provide a self-declaration, signed by the Italian spouse pursuant to Artt. 46 and 47 DPR n. 445/2000, confirming the ongoing marriage status.
8	<input type="checkbox"/>	In order to qualify for the free of visa fee application, copy of the roundtrip airline tickets showing the applicant and the EU citizen travelling together, or proof that the applicant is traveling to reach the EU citizen residing in Italy;

If one of the parents is abroad, he/she will be asked by the Consulate to contact the nearest Italian Consulate/Embassy in order to sign the consent letter in front of an officer;c) Birth certificate: No birth certificate is required if the full name of both parents/legal guardians are mentioned (in English) in the applicant's passport; If not, an original or certified copy of the birth certificate (translated in Italian or English), duly legalized, must be provided;d) Divorced parents: unless clearly stated in an original/legalized copy of the divorce sentence mentioning full custody (translated in Italian or English), both parents are required to sign the NOC as described in point c);e) In case of death of one of the parents, a legalized death certificate must be provided. <p>Originals and/or certified copies will be returned if a copy is provided.</p> |
